I am in receipt of your letter to District Attorney Steve Cooley dated August 22, 2011, alleging misconduct by the Los Angeles Community College Board. As to your allegation that bond funds were misspent, this office has previously determined that no criminal investigation is warranted. That continues to be our position. As to the findings of the California State Controller that there were irregularities in the selection of the inspector general, the Public Integrity Division will conduct an inquiry.
